**CITIZEN PETITION TO THE BALTIMORE COUNTY EXECUTIVE,
THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE COUNTY COUNCIL.**

We, the undersigned ask that the design and call for bids for the Shawan Rd/Cuba Rd intersection upgrade be temporarily postponed so that alternative concepts can be explored. Consensus from the affected communities has not been reached regarding the plans for the intersection. Surrounding community organizations** are offering to sponsor a workshop conducted by a renowned planning expert to gather data and opinions from all stakeholders. We ask that the county participate with us in the workshop with their data and input. We strongly believe that the workshop process will be educational, will result in community-driven concepts, and will satisfy residents that the far-reaching effects of this intersection redesign have been taken into consideration. This process will foster an improved level of communication and cooperation between the county and the residents of communities affected by the permanence of the proposed changes. We represent a united effort to actively seek alternative, sustainable solutions to traffic management that affect surrounding communities and the Shawan Rd corridor.
